Trail-based recreation	- <i>Potato Range - easily-travelled subalpine and alpine terrain, well-established trails, extensive alpine meadows, numerous lakes - popular hiking and horseback riding destination, occasional mountain biking</i> - <i>Lincoln Pass - old-growth Douglas fir forest, numerous lakes, open grassland slopes, heritage trail - hiking, horseback riding, occasional mountain biking</i> - <i>Choelquoit Lake - grasslands and open forest - hiking and riding trail along south side lake</i> - <i>Chilko River valley - trail along east slope of river valley from Henry's Crossing (bridge) to Chilko Lake - horseback riding, hiking</i> - <i>Tsuniah Ridge - horseback riding, hiking</i> - <i>Mt. Nemaia - hiking, horseback riding</i>
Ecological values	- <i>diverse vegetation from valley to alpine, including wetlands, spruce, pine and Douglas fir forest, grassland, and alpine meadow</i> - <i>large mammals include California bighorn sheep, grizzly, black bear, mountain goat, cougar, mule deer, moose, wolf</i> - <i>large valley bottom lakes - Tatlayoko, Chilko, Choelquoit, Tsuniah, and Konni</i>

<sup>1</sup>The condition of trails and routes is rated as *good*, *moderate*, or *rough* to provide an indication of the ease of following a trail or route, the presence of trail and route impediments (such as windfall, poor drainage, difficult stream crossings), and the level of trail maintenance, relative to other trails and routes in the system.
